



Energy Roundtable Event at Harvard Business School United States and Russia's Commercial Relationship

Purpose

Recently, Russia and the United States have encountered differences over a growing list of commercial issues. These differences threaten to compromise the potential for a wide range of trade and investment opportunities in a variety of business sectors, including energy. The purpose of this roundtable is to facilitate informed dialogue on the barriers and bridges to the expanded engagement of our nations through commerce, investment and trade, so that our growing common interests can provide new impetus for resolving differences.

Structure

The roundtable will include four to five presentations from distinguished panelists, including members from the commercial sector (CEO level) and government sector (senior level officials), along with a moderated discussion. Each panelist will present a five minute overview regarding his/her organization's specific interest in the U.S./Russia relationship, the role of energy in building a commercial bridge to advance the U.S./Russia relationship, and the challenges and opportunities ahead. The roundtable will conclude with a closing summary from the moderator and informal panel interaction with attendees.
